

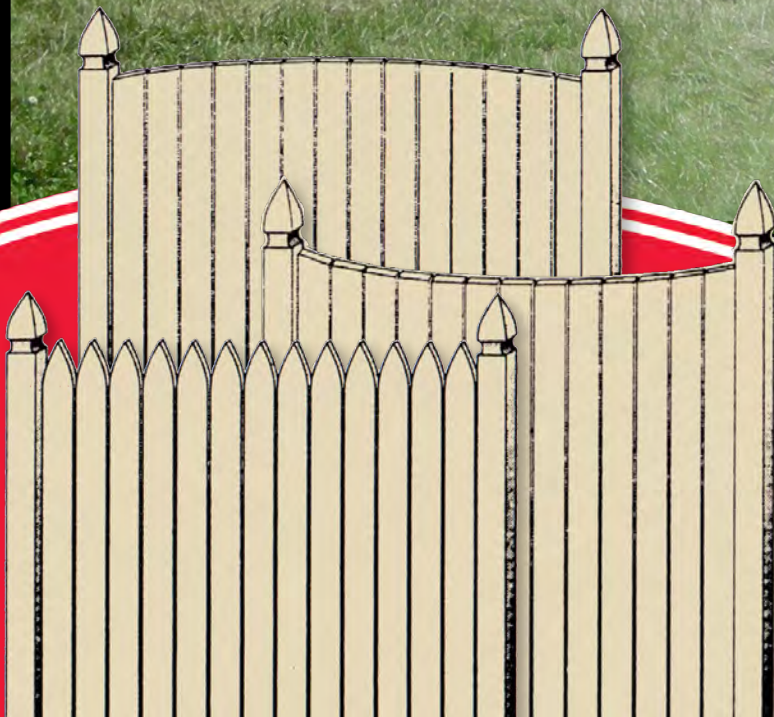

»» Western Red Cedar

»» Installation

Installation of your wood fence, no matter the type, follows a time tested formula, enhanced with modern technology. We use state of the art excavation equipment to dig an extremely large hole, set all of your posts in wet concrete (mixed on site from aggregate, water and cement), and custom fabricate each fence section, almost exclusively on site, to conform to each individual yard. ***Quality checks are routinely performed to ensure that our strict standards are met and your installation, from start to finish, turns into another quality fence project indicative of the Iroquois Fence brand.***

»» Preservation

Upon completion of your new wood fence, we highly recommend you take the time to protect your investment with a high quality preservative treatment. Applying a clear sealant or a colored stain, either semi-transparent or solid, will enhance the beauty of your fence, as well as prolong the natural weathering process. Your first application should be applied approximately 6 months after initial installation (Red Cedar only requires a wait time of 1 month). Additional coats should be applied every 4-5 years depending on wear and weather exposure. Check with your local paint store for information on which preservative is right for your application.

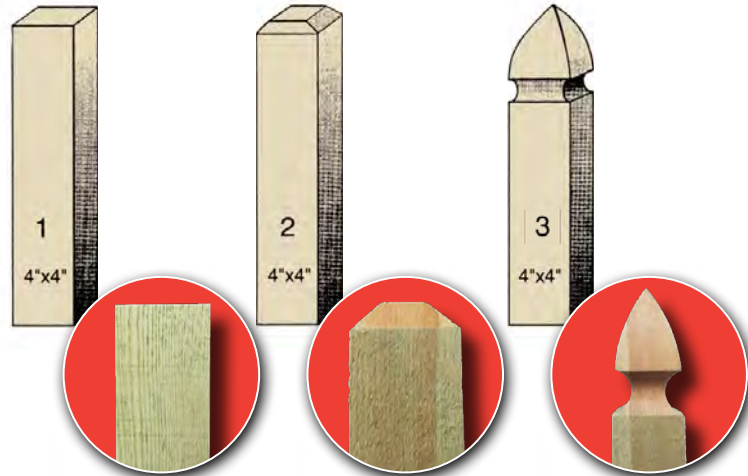

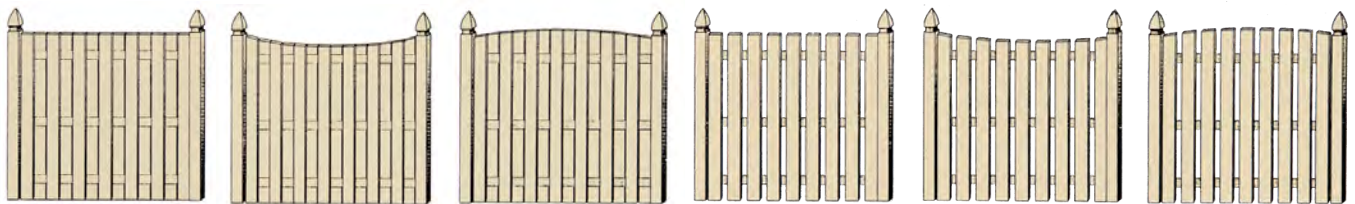

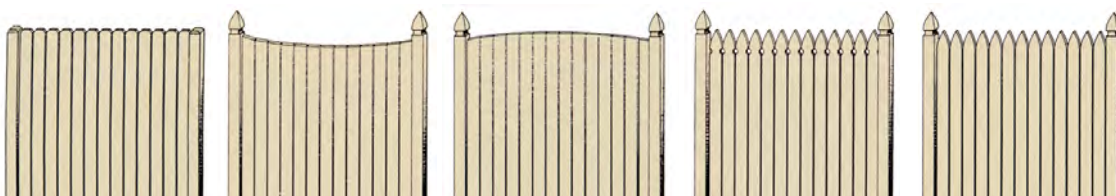
